

Term 1 report of the Activities Executive

Overview and purpose

The purpose of this report is to update the Board on the business conducted by the Activities Executive during Term 1 of 2018-19.

Meetings & Membership

Meetings were held bi-weekly through September, October, November and December and the members were: Lauren Huxley (Chair), Alex Stoker, Barbora Rozkopalova, Chavi Kohli, Charlie Hammersley, Tara Rogerson, Indeera Shankla, Lydia Okoibhole, Nathan Mayfield, Dalia Landau, Mollie Ford, Emma Jacobs, India Garrett, Jonathan Kershaw and Kate Hamilton.

Decisions were taken on the basis of a 7 member quorum, and were taken either in person or using agreed digital platforms.

Terms of Reference

The Activities Executive oversees the discipline of Student Activities Groups, agrees the subsidy and other LUU grants to Student Activities Groups, and approves the setting up of new groups and closure of existing ones. They also oversee all business pertaining to Clubs and Societies constituted under LUU.

Strategic Risks

The Activities Exec have no official responsibility in managing Strategic Risks, but their work contributes to the management of;

SR8: Reputation with students is poor in areas of our strategy namely representation and student support.

Key areas of work

Society Formation

In term 1 the Activities Executive reviewed and approved the formation of 1 new society, Bowling.

LUU Grant Allocation

The Activities Executive had two rounds of funding allocation within term 1. In round one, they approved 20 out of 25 applications, amounting to £29,305.31, and in round two, they approved 11 out of 25 applications, amounting to £7,237.60.

This means that a total of £36,542.91 has been given to clubs and societies so far this academic year in grant funding.

Society Communications & Representation

The Activities Executive considered a number of Union-Wide events and decisions, for communication with their societies. The Activities Executive also discussed feedback from their Executive Category Meetings.
